

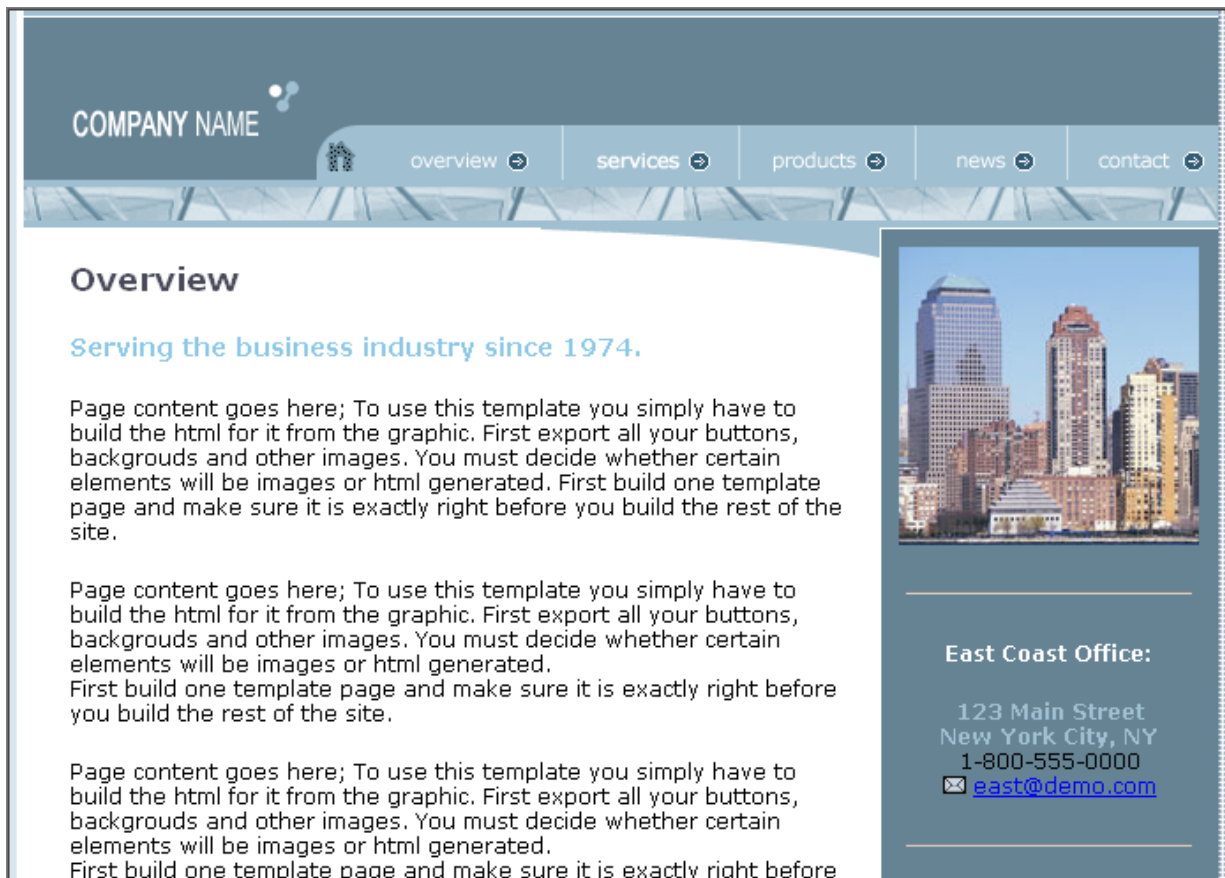
HOW IT WORKS:
